Scope and Quantities of Work:

The Work of this project consists of grading, laying base, and paving a 24' wide ditch section road over Progress Avenue and a section of the old Farmers Market in northeast Pelham. Progress Avenue is an existing half paved and half dirt road that is 0.38 miles long. The paved portion will be resurfaced. 375' of new road will be built to connect Progress Avenue to Old Ga 3 through the old Farmers Market property. Estimated quantities for the above-mentioned work will include 6,885 SY of 8" GAB, 922 Tons of 2.5" 19 mm Superpave Asphalt, 738 Tons of 2" 9.5 mm Superpave Asphalt, 2,348 Gal of Primer and Tack, 302 LF of Storm Pipes, Grading Complete, Traffic Control, NPDES Measures, Erosion and Sediment Control BMP's, Driveways, Striping, Installing New Signs, Clearing and Grubbing, and various other related accessories and appurtenances as shown on the Drawings and called for in the Contract Documents.

Bids shall be on a unit price basis with lump sum prices for certain items of the Work.
