With a quorum present, Mayor Eubanks called the meeting to order at 6:35 p.m. followed by the Pledge of Allegiance to the flag. Mayor Eubanks provided the opening prayer.

AGENDA

Council Member Shiver made a motion to approve the agenda, seconded by Mayor Pro-Tem Brown. The vote was unanimous.

COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES

Council Member Adams made a motion to approve the Council Minutes of February 16, 2023, and the Work Session Minutes of March 9, 2023, as distributed, seconded by Mayor Pro-Tem Brown. The vote was unanimous.

FY22 BUDGET AMENDMENTS

The purpose of the FY22 budget amendments is required in order to balance the City's FY22 budget. State law requires local governments to have a balanced budget. An outline was provided of each line item in the previous budget that needed amending.

Council Member Shiver made a motion to approve the FY22 budget amendments as presented, seconded by Mayor Pro-Tem Brown. The vote was unanimous.

FIRE RECOVERY USA

The purpose of the Service Agreement is to allow the City of Pelham to seek the services to assist with the billing for services that the city provides in connection with motor vehicle incidents and other public safety service incidents. The Service Agreement will be between Fire Recovery USA, LLC and The City of Pelham.

Council Member Brown made a motion to enter into a Service Agreement with Fire Recovery USA, seconded by Council Member Davis. The vote was unanimous.

The purpose of the Ordinance is to establish and implement a program to change mitigation rates for the deployment of emergency and non-emergency services by the fire department for services provided/rendered for the City of Pelham.

Council Member Davis made a motion to adopt an Ordinance establishing and implementing a program to charge mitigation rates for the deployment of emergency and non-emergency services by the fire department for services provided/rendered for the City of Pelham and dispense with the second reading, seconded by Council Member Shiver. The vote was unanimous.

GEFA LOAN MODIFICATION

The purpose of the GEFA loan modification is to extend the life of the loan without any additional money.

Council Member Adams made a motion to approve the GEFA loan modification for CWDRA20011, and DWDRA20016, seconded by Council Member Davis. The vote was unanimous.

GEFA LIFT STATION PROJECT BID AWARD

The City of Pelham held a bid opening on March 2nd for the lift station project W1612-01601. Two bids were received. The first bid was from RPI Underground Inc. for \$741,253 and the second bid was from James Warren and Associates for \$941,300. The city engineer recommends that the project be awarded to RPI Underground Inc. for the lift station improvement project.

Council Member Adams made a motion to award the lift station improvement project to RPI Underground Inc. in the amount of \$741,253, seconded by Council Member Shiver. The vote was unanimous.

ADJOURN

With no further business to come before Pelham City Council, Council Member Robinson made a motion to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Council Member Davis. The vote was unanimous. Mayor Eubanks declared the meeting closed at 6:52 p.m.
