COUNCIL MEETING MINUTES

Mayor Pro Tem Brown made a motion to approve the minutes from March 16th Council Meeting and April 13th Work Session, seconded by Council Member Davis. The vote was unanimous.

COUNCIL RETREAT

Council Member Adams made a motion to authorize the city manager to sign a contract with GMA to allow GMA staff to facilitate the council retreat at the cost of \$2,000, seconded by Council Member Shiver. The vote was unanimous.

GEORGIA CITIES WEEK RESOLUTION

Council Member Brown made a motion to adopt the resolution to mark April 23-29, 2023 as Georgia Cities Week for Pelham, seconded by Mayor Pro Tem Brown. The vote was unanimous.

PROGRESS AVE BID AWARD

Council Member Davis made a motion to accept the bid from Green's Backhoe Inc. for \$868,411.40 with a 3% contingency, making the total \$894,463.74, seconded by Council member Robinson. The vote was unanimous.

CINCO DE MAYO ROAD CLOSURE

Council member Shiver made a motion to approve the road closure for a portion of Mathewson Ave for Chuy's Cinco de Mayo event, seconded by Council Member Robinson. The vote was unanimous.

CINCO DE MAYO ALCOHOL REQUEST

Council Member Shiver made a motion to approve the alcohol request for Chuy's Cinco de Mayo event, seconded by Council Member Robinson. The vote was unanimous.

ARPA FUNDS ALLOCATION REQUEST

Council Member Adams made a motion to approve the request to utilize \$75,000 of ARPA funds to outfit the new fire engine that was purchased by the fire department, \$50,000 of ARPA funds for necessary repairs to City Hall, and \$100,000 of ARPA funds to make necessary repairs to the Donnie Cochran Community Center, seconded by Mayor Pro Tem Brown. The vote was unanimous.

With no further business to come before the Pelham City Council, Council Member Robinson made a motion to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Mayor Pro-Tem Brown. The vote was unanimous. Mayor Eubanks declared the meeting closed at 7:04 p.m.
