City Manager Drake also discussed the receipt of a full-time fire fighter application, the first in several years, within one month of the fire department moving to the 24/48 shift.

City Manager Drake is recommending the Council approve the obligation of the rest of the City's ARPA funds totaling \$608, 900.23. The suggested obligations are: \$200,000 to transfer into the General fund, \$200,000 for City facilities, and \$208,900.23 for infrastructure inprovements.
