CONVEY INDUSTRIAL PROPERTIES TO THE PDA

Previously, the Council approved the establishment of the Pelham Development Authority that would promote growth and development in the City's industrial park. There are four parcels of land that the City currently owns in the industrial park totaling 17.794 acres. Transferring ownership of the parcels to the PDA will allow them to market the parcels and enter into sales agreements with potential developers. City Manager Drake is recommending the Council approve the transfer of ownership of the parcels to the PDA without any associated conditions.
