DDA/PDA BOARD APPOINTEE

. DDA/PDA Director Cameron Harris has nominated Mr. Cullen Edwards, a citizen and business owner, to fill the 7th position on the Downtown Development Authority/Pelham Development Authority boards. Mr. Edwards meets the requirements to serve on the board as outlined in the current DDA/PDA charters.

City Manager Drake is recommending the Council approve the appointment of Mr. Cullen Edwards to the DDA and PDA boards.

EMPLOYEE ASSISTANCE PROGRAM CONTRACT

City Manager Drake presented an Employee Assistance Program contract. The contract will be with the Employee Assistance Programs division of John D. Archbold Memorial Hospital. The purpose of the Employee Assistance Program will be to enhance the well-being of city employees as well as improve overall organizational performance. The program aims to promote physical and mental fitness, provide a

mechanism for resolution, and enhance health and performance. The contract will begin July 1, 2024, and cost \$1080.00 for the first year.

City Manager Drake is recommending the Council approve entering the Employee Assistance Program with John D. Archbold Memorial Hospital.


